Policy for the use of the Rostrum/ Podium

Purpose

A rostrum/podium is essential for the effective visibility of the LWC conductor to enable him/ her to see the choir, and also the choir to see the conductor when performing concerts at venues where no elevation for the conductor is available. To address the health and safety issues associated with using inappropriate equipment.

Procedure

The rostrum is the accepted form of elevation to be used at all concerts where there is no other means of elevation for the conductor to use which adheres with the health and safety issues.

The transportation of the rostrum will only be undertaken by persons who have been given the suitable training of the handling and assembling of the rostrum.

The Health and Safety lead/Gareth Howells must be involved in visits to all venues requiring the use of the system before a concert is performed.

This policy will be reviewed every three years.

Responsibility

The overall responsibility and implementation of this policy lies with the executive committee of the LWC.
