Liverpool Welsh Choral Uniform

A black folder is needed to hold all your music and a small black bag may be taken on stage. Perfumes and cologne should be kept to a minimum.

Sopranos and Altos

Black choir tunic

Long black skirt <u>or</u> smart black trousers (not skinny jeans or leggings)

Black tights or pop socks

Scarf as provided

Any additional embellishment

Choir pin

Black shoes

Tenors and Basses

Black jacket

Black trousers

Black socks

Black or white shirt (as directed)

Coloured tie <u>or</u> bow tie (as directed)

Choir pin

Black shoes

Items of uniform provided by the choir should be returned if a choir member finds they have to leave

In recognition of the cost of any uniform items, choir members pay only 50% of choir subs in their first year.

Uniform requirements (provided by the choir):

- The black music folder for concert performances will be provided free of charge
- Scarfs, bow ties and ties will be provided by the uniform secretary free of charge (to be returned if people leave)
- Tunics ,which are made specially to order for the choir, are to be purchased from uniform secretary at a cost of £27.50 and 50% of this cost will be returned if people return it in good condition if they leave

Other items (to be provided by choir members themselves following the uniform guidance) include:

- smart 'formal' black trousers or skirts which must not be tight to the legs and must touch the shoes for sopranos and altos
- smart black dinner jacket or black suit jacket for basses and altos
- smart black shirt for basses and tenors
- smart white shirt for basses and tenors
- smart black shoes or ankle boots which will be hidden under the trouser leg
- black tights or black knee- high pop socks or socks

The professional presentation of the choir makes an important contribution to how our performances are received and perceived and although every effort will be made to help, if a choir member is not dressed appropriately for a concert they may, regrettably, not be permitted to sing at a concert.

If a choir member finds that they are unable to dress appropriately for financial reasons, please discuss this with the Uniform Secretary in the first instance.
